- That the College shall make available all the requisite infrastructure for successful completion of training course(s), as per the laid Government and other norms.
- That the College shall mobilize the students as per the defined eligibility criteria & documents as per the PMKVY 4.0 NSDC CSSM, MSSDS guidelines.
- 5. That on the day of the assessment, the College shall ensure that the necessary facilities are provided to the assessor and adequate labour Technology.



#### 7. DURATION AND TERMINATION

The MoU may be terminated by both parties within thirty days of a written notice for any reason whatsoever. There is no obligation pending upon either party after the termination of the MoU. The MoU may be renewed by both parties for another term as per mutual understanding after the expiration of the term. Either Party shall have the right to terminate this MoU by notice in writing with immediate effect if the other Party:

#### 8. FORCE MAJEURE

Neither Party shall be liable for failure to meet their obligations due to event of Force Majeure. Force Majeure is taken to mean events, including but not limited to strikes, blockade, war, riots, natural disaster, refusal of license by State/ Central Government authorities, court orders, in so far as such event(s) prevents or delays either Party from fulfilling its obligations hereunder. In case the Force Majeure conditions continue for more than fifteen (15) days, Parties shall discuss the effect of such conditions regarding this MoU and mutually decide the course of action to be followed, including but not limited to termination of this MoU.

## 9. CHOICE OF LAW/FORUM

## 10. CONFIDENTIALITY OBLIGATIONS

In connection with this MOU and the terms herein provided, all parties may exchange certain confidential information (the "Confidential Information"). All parties shall keep confidentiality of all data and other information supplied to each other under this MOU and shall not sell or otherwise make that information available to any third parties, except for such information which is publicly known or if such disclosure is required by law or a regulatory order. Each party shall restrict all confidential information to its staff and employees on a "need-to-know" basis. This obligation shall survive the termination of this MOU.

## 11. AMENDMENT AND WAIVER

This MOU contains the entire MOU between the parties and the provisions hereto may not be amended, modified or waived, and no such amendment, modification or waiver shall be effective, unless agreed upon mutually, made in writing and executed under seal on behalf of the parties.

### 12. RESOLUTION OF CONFLICT

Amicable settlement: The parties shall, in the first instance, seek to resolve any dispute amicably through mutual consultation. Any dispute arising out of the contract, which cannot be amicably settled between the parties, shall be referred to the arbitrator. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties.

## 13. NON-DISCRIMINATION

In performing this MoU, the parties agree not to discriminate on the grounds of age, race, national origin, veteran status or religious orientation. Any institution (University/College) desirous of offering skill based courses from the year at the level of certificate, diploma, advance diploma, B.Voc./M.Voc. Degree should apply to University Grants Commission (UGC) on the portal <u>ugc.aicte-india.org</u>.

#### Who should apply?

1. Institutions starting skill courses including B.Voc./M.Voc. for the first time,

Institutions already approved under NSQF Scheme i.e Community College, B.Voc. and DDU Kaushal Kendras,

3. Institutions which have been running skill courses earlier, needs to apply on this portal for the academic session 2019-20.

#### Submission of application

The college/universities would need to upload information on the following parameters:

- Name of the Proposed programme(s) along with trade/sector
- Proposed Intake of the students
- Alignment with National Occupational Standard of the Sector Skill Council and National Skill Qualification Framework
- Any market survey for the employment of the students
- Laboratory or Workshop required for the proposed Programme
- Establishment of industry linkages

The permission for running the skill programs and for providing funding will be separate. Now the application called for is only for grant of permission for running the skill courses. The applications for financial aid shall be called for later on. Institutions are encouraged to run the courses by generating their own resources. In case the funding is provided, it shall be only on the following terms.

i. The training facilities and the infrastructure could be funded by the Central Government.

ii. The training facilities could be run by industry concerned or such other third party agencies and the cost of vocational instructors could be met by the State Government.


iii. The consumables and recurring expenditure for the training shall be collected as a fee from the students.

The last date of submission of application on the portal is 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2019. On the basis of the information provided on the above parameters, the UGC shall convey its permission to the institution for running the skill course immediately after the last date of application.

### Types of Courses and Awards

The courses offered should be as per the National Skill Qualifications Framework (NSQF). There will be full time credit-based modular programmes, wherein banking of credits for skill and general education components shall be permitted so as to enable multiple exit and entry.



The multiple entry and exit enables the learner to seek employment after any level of Award and join back as and when feasible to upgrade qualifications / skill competencies either to move higher in the job profile or in the higher educational system. This will also provide the learner an opportunity for vertical mobility to second year of B.Voc degree programme after one year diploma and to third year of B.Voc degree programme after a two year advanced diploma. The students may further move to Masters and Research degree programmes mapped at NSQF Level 8 – 10. Awards shall be given at each stage for cumulative credits awarded to the learners in skill based vocational courses.

The courses under NSQF shall also provide for vertical mobility to the students with vocational subjects in school level. The Universities shall enable horizontal & vertical mobility to the students of vocational stream at 10+2 level in various courses at undergraduate level. The Table depicts qualification flow and vertical and lateral mobility options for the learners in skill development based education.

### **Brief Proposal of Certificate Course in Gardner**

Sunderrao Solanke Mahavidhyalaya Majalgaon, Dist. Beed is a multifaculty college established in June 1971 and known for good academic excellence in the region. The college is run by Marathwada Shikshan Prasarak Mandal Aurangabad, which established in 1958 and identified as renowned educational institute in the Maharashtra state. The college has 2020 students in junior college, 1680 students in senior college. The college has 26 senior college teachers, 57 teachers in junior college and 63 non-teaching staff members. the college has its own separate building of library with 3950 books and subscribed 67 journals and periodicals in different languages.

The college has 25 acres land of its own. The constructed building spread over about 3 acres of land. Beside there is an adequate open land around and in between the building. The college has 35 classrooms, 8 laboratories, Canteen, indoor outdoor stadium facility, separate Library building and 7 toilets existing at present.
